

Re. PLAYING FIELD ADJOINING THE SITE OF

CLEEVE PRIOR C.E. (CONTROLLED) SCHOOL

We, the undersigned, being Trustees of the above mentioned playing field by virtue of a decision taken at a Parish Vestry Meeting held on the 15th day of October, 1857, do hereby give the Cleeve Prior Parish Council permission to have the use of that part of the playing field defined on the attached plan and edged red on the following conditions:

(CROSS-HATCHED)

- (a) during school hours the field and equipment may be used only by children under school age, who must be accompanied by an adult.
- (b) the Head Teacher will have the right to control the use of the wholefield during school hours.
- (c) suitable provision for mowing the area must be maintained to our satisfaction.

This provision includes the erection of playground equipment by the Parish Council, such equipment remaining their property and its maintenance being their responsibility.


