282 WDC Cllr Lasota Report:

- A. 14.12.17 WDC meeting planned to discuss planning and enforcement.
- B. Police, Birmingham Anglers and A Saunders (PPW) requested concrete barriers be erected near Stubbs Pond and possibly a few other gaps which would restrict vehicle access. The Council used emergency decision powers in resolving to pay up to £100 for the purpose of installing concrete barriers on CP547 near Stubbs Pond.
- C. There was illegal quad bike activity in the parish last week.
- D. Trees have come down near Suncourt. Cllr Lasota spoke with the owner and he intends to cut trees.
- E. Fly tipping problems continue on CPO land. Chair Robinson will continue to engage in conversations with local residents about this issue.

Chair Robinson requested Cllr Lasota to ask for an update regarding Traveller Site plots with temporary planning.

PROGRESS REPORTS

- On 16.10.17 the Clerk emailed P Saunders of WRS to request the Quarry Lane ditch be checked again for pollution. There is evidence that household contamination is ongoing. On 10.10.17 the Clerk informed Mr A Fell of WDC that the Quarry Lane ditch needs to be cleared.
- The Clerk is working on the Community Asset Application for the Birmingham Anglers land adjacent to the Wharf. Dates and photos of events are required. **ACTION: Clir Smith to provide information**.
- Mrs Bolton Bungalow: On 02.10.17 the Clerk requested the tree branch over the footpath to be trimmed. C Wood is investigating the ownership of the tree. On 14.11.17 the Clerk requested an update and was informed the site has yet to be assessed.

 ACTION: Clerk to request Lengthsman to cut the branch. The Clerk advised that the Council should not be spending public money to carry out work on private land without permission.
