

CLEEVE PRIOR PARISH COUNCIL

PROPOSAL FORM

Meeting Date: 10.12.18.

Proposer/Agenda Item: Cllr P Wilson.

Purpose: To warn traffic, travelling west to east on Cleeve Prior Main Street, of the car parking hazard between Froglands and The Close. This is intended to prevent further incidents of collision and near misses of which several have occurred in recent months.



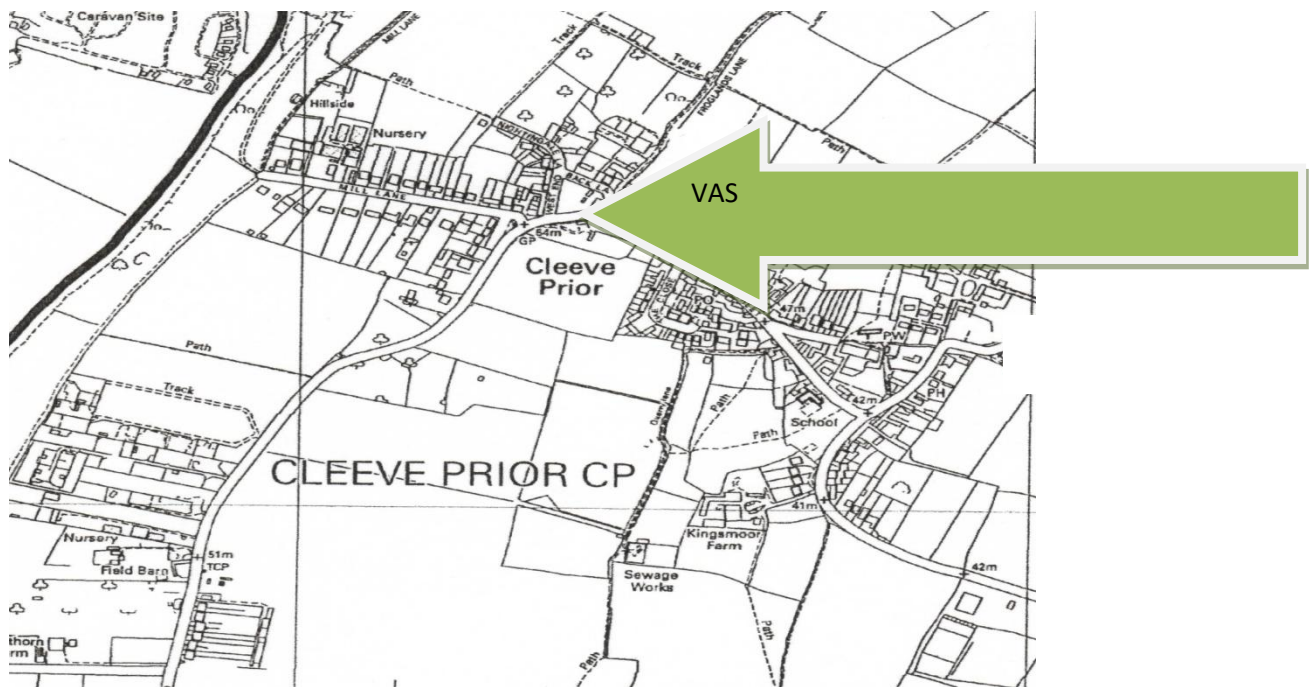
Proposal: To procure and install solar powered, radar operated electronic sign on Main St adjacent to Cleeve Barn. See the diagram below.

Total Cost: £3060 (procure & install) via SWARCO

Parish Consultation: N/A

Recommendation: The Parish Council is recommended to authorise the expenditure.

Commentary: The hazard described above has been addressed in the past using a mobile electronic sign. This was shared with N.Littleton and is no longer available. Discussions have concluded that a permanent sign owned by Cleeve Prior would be effective in addressing the increased number of incidents on this stretch of road. G Brienza of WCC has contributed highways advice on the viability and location of a new sign. The possibility of a second sign to be used for traffic approaching from the other direction (E to W) had been posited and may be addressed in the next financial year when the impact of this proposal has been evaluated.

The WCC Senior Highways Liaison Engineer (G Brienza) inspected the proposal for equipment and location and has confirmed the recommendations. He will undertake the formalities for highways intervention (installation of pole) when the funding for the equipment is agreed.

Three quotations have been obtained and can be inspected. The preferred supplier is SWARCO. A one year warranty is provided and a basic maintenance contract is available if required at £85 per year.
